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Certification

The certification which provide advantages has requirements

- Past Performance
- Current contract
- Management ability and other factors

Certifications

- HUB Zone
 - Economic based program
 - 10% of federal spending can be set aside for HUB Zone companies
 - Two or more companies
- 8(a)
 - Economically and socially disadvantaged program
 - 10% of federal spending can be under 8(a) program
- Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business
 - VA provided letter of service related disability
 - VA is only agency that can award direct contracts to SDVOSB



8(a) company

- >>50% owned and controlled by eligible individual
 - >Financial and management
- ➤ Organized for profit
 - ➤ Tax records for two years
 - ➤ Key personnel: resumes and licenses
 - Financial records: P &L, Bal Sheet, Loans, Bank signature card
 - ➤ Work in progress, completed contracts
 - ➤ Corporate records: Articles of Incorporation, By-laws, minutes
 - >Leases, insurance, bonding, equipment, licenses
 - > Have been in business for two or more years



8(a) Disadvantage Narrative

When – Explain when the discriminatory conduct occurred. Exact dates are not necessary so long as the incident provides a specific time period. This discrimination can be from any period of your life.

Where – Explain where the discriminatory conduct occurred. The incident must have occurred in American society.

Who – Explain who committed the discriminatory action. This could include an individual, a group of individuals, or an institution. Individual names, where available, are preferred but not necessary so long as the incident provides a specific figure or organization.

What – Explain the discriminatory conduct.

Why – Explain the reason(s) that the conduct was more likely motivated by bias or discrimination. A mere assertion that the action was the result of bias or discrimination is will not be enough to support a claim of social disadvantage.

How - Explain how each instance of discriminatory conduct impacted your entry into or advancement in the business world.
